

VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: Tutor

DESCRIPTION: An individual who invests time with a child, working on academic skills in a one-on-one setting during the school year. This could be as simple as reading with a child or assisting a child with their worksheets in math, reading comprehension, or writing. You can work with one child for about 30 minutes-1 hour or a few children, back-to-back. Tutors may come one day per week or more if available.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Minimum age requirement is twenty-one.
- 2. Must be Charlotte area resident for at least six months before volunteering.
- 3. Complete an application with references, background checks, and interviews with staff members.
- 4. Complete orientation with staff to better understand the special needs of the children, agency mission, and agency expectations.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Consistently strive to balance personal needs, agency's needs, and child's needs.
- 2. Begin a relationship with a child with staff supervision and support.
- 3. Work closely with direct care staff, Volunteer Engagement Officer to ensure a successful experience for all involved.
- 4. Participate in volunteer evaluation process and provide regular feedback to AYN staff.
- 5. Commit to working as a member of the AYN team and make all decisions in the best interest of the agency and the children.

TIME COMMITMENT REQUIRED:

- 1. Minimum of three months duration during the school year.
- 2. 30 minutes -1 hour per week during school hours.
